The safety procedures and regulations below apply to everyone carrying out operations under the authority of Team Rembrandts. This concerns members of Team Rembrandts and individuals attending events hosted by Team Rembrandts and its associates and those who visited Team Rembrandts building location.

Please read the regulations thoroughly and place your signature on the last page as proof of compliance. The signed form will be added to your personnel file.

General regulations

Everybody is obliged to:

1. use common sense when judging situations concerning safety and take immediate action to secure your safety, as well as the safety of others.
2. take action when (possible) danger occurs and report this (possible) danger to a Mentor.
3. drive slowly at the building location territory and take notice of one-way-traffic and all legislative traffic rules.
4. keep emergency exits free at all times. The emergency exits may only be used during emergency situations.
5. keep general order and decency in the working areas and aisles, as well as the proper use of tools in the workspace.
6. keep at least one-meter distance from running machines without further approval of a Mentor.
7. follow safety instructions of a third party when working at any of their locations (for example partners or suppliers) and take the Team Rembrandts Safety instructions as a minimum standard.
8. keep aisles and footpaths free at all times. It's not allowed to park goods or (temporary) materials without considering the safety on the aisles/footpaths.

Everybody is prohibited to:

1. unnecessary shout or throw, smash or drop objects. This is to prevent scaring others.
2. wear ties, hats/caps, necklaces e.g. at the building location or in the pit. To be judged by the Mentors.
3. use or possess alcohol and/or drugs inside the building location premises, both during and outside of working hours.
4. smoke inside the building of Team Rembrandts. This also counts for the preparations to smoke (rolling a cigarette).
5. work alone in a room, not even when you are working overtime.
6. open emergency exits or remove protection measures.

Furthermore, members can refuse to take actions (imposed by a mentor or partner) that are unsafe in their opinion. When this occurs, the member should report this at the board of Team Rembrandts with a reason of the refusal.

Protective measures

Everybody must:

1. wear and use Personal Protection Measure clothing in the following situations:
 - a. When engaging in activities for which everybody is obliged to wear safety shoes, working cloths (such like overall and dustcoat) at any time.
 - b. Situational or area restricted measures such as safety goggles, earplugs, helmet, safety harness for working at heights, dustcovers, isolated tools as such.
2. know about present dangerous goods / hazardous substances and safe use of it. (see also action items on behalf of inventory by department).
3. apply the correct use of hoisting- and lifting devices. Lifting and hoisting over another one's head is prohibited.
4. put garbage directly in the right container or dustbin.
5. use an extension cord properly and prevent tripping due to use of it.
6. must wear a safety belt and helmet when working above 2,5 meters. Team members working close must also wear a helmet.
7. have the permission of a Mentor to use spray cans (varnish, underseal, Motorplast, brake cleaner) at the therefore arranged places.
8. stop using broken things (such as chains, cables, ropes, tools, electro wires and sockets) and directly offer the material to a Mentor for reparation or disposal. Do not dispose of these items yourself.

Activities

1. Installations and machines need to be left behind in safety mode (for example never leave a machine running when you leave).
2. Only use machines after approval of a Mentor. During overtime and on Saturday's only after approval of the responsible person within production/assembly during that part of the day.
3. No unauthorized use of machines and installations. Operations can only be initiated after approval of a Lead Mentor, or after the responsible person who can approve this use during overtime.
4. Nobody may work with gas, air, electricity and water without approval of the utility facility.
5. Never remove safety measures and never disconnect a fire or safety- alarm.
6. Always use an extraction hood during welding or soldering.
7. No leaning or hanging on machines or installations, even when they are not functional.
8. Fork-lift trucks may only be used by those who are licensed to.
9. When using compressed air to remove splinters or dirt, make sure that your fellow members are not bothered. Before using compressed air inform them, so measures can be taken to prevent inconvenience.

Regarding visitors who need to be in the building location.

1. If visitors are near working members or the robot, they need to wear safety glasses.
2. Wearing of minimal personal protection measures (amongst which are safety shoes) by members who are often in the work shop or working on the robot is obligated. For example, software members during testing and controlling the robot.

General safety standards
